Thank you for your recent response to my Right-to-Know request.

After reviewing the response, I have one remaining point of clarification concerning the scope of the search.

My request sought records documenting the contemporaneous legal basis for the criminal trespass warning and subsequent enforcement action. Your response certifies that certain categories of responsive records do not exist following a comprehensive search.

Could you please clarify whether the search included records documenting:

- any written criminal trespass warning;
- any contemporaneous record memorializing the factual basis for directing my removal;
- any written record identifying the objective facts supporting the subsequent arrest; and
- any non-investigative administrative records documenting those actions?

I am not requesting reconsideration of your response or attempting to relitigate the underlying incident. I am simply seeking clarification regarding the scope of the search so that I accurately understand the agency's position.
